Instructions for Poster Presentations

- The following guidelines will be of help when you prepare your poster presentation.
- If you wish to present a poster at the conference, kindly submit your abstract to the scientific committee of NCORE 2019 for review.
- Once your abstract is accepted by the scientific committee of NCORE 2019, please prepare the poster as per the following instructions.
- A PDF version of the completed poster has to be uploaded through the website on or before 25 Sep 2019.
- Please remember that it is very important to prepare your poster BEFORE the conference and to bring it yourself.

ABOUT THE POSTER SESSION

- The Poster Session will be organized on 29th September 2019 during the conference at the Venue.
- Poster presenters are to be present at the venue at 8 a.m. on Sep 29 2019. They will be advised of the poster viewing time at the venue so that they can engage themselves in discussions with the delegates.
- Posters to be put up at the venue between 8am – 8:30am on 29th Sep 2019
- Materials to secure the poster on the boards will be provided by the organizers.
- We do not assume any responsibility for material displayed on the poster boards.
- Material of your poster – 3 mm foam board with vinyl print.
- Poster board size: Size of usable area: 4 ft high x 3 ft. wide

PREPARING YOUR CONTENT

- The header should have the name of the conference – 2nd Annual NICE Conference on PEDIATRIC NEURO REHABILITATION and the footer should have Co-hosted by St.Isabel's Hospital.
- The title and name of the author (s) should appear at the top of the poster with a minimum font size of 18.
- Use a clear typeface and, if possible, a laser printer. The poster should be readable from 2-3 meters, indicating that all lettering should be at least 8mm high, with a minimum font size of 24.
- Graphs and figures should be readable from 2-3 meters. They should be drawn with a minimum line width of 1 mm.

We encourage Handouts. 'Handouts', photocopies of your presentation reduced to A4 format are welcome. If you wish to distribute handouts, you should prepare them beforehand and bring them with you.
